Priority IAC is a dairy microbiology company located on County CR in Manitowoc. To help them meet their growing space needs, A.C.E. will construct a 1,000 square-foot office addition onto an existing storage area that will also be renovated into office space. A 6000-square-foot warehouse with a loading dock and larger parking area are included in the expansion project.

Reinforcing their commitment to building green, A.C.E. will be reusing some of the lumber salvaged from the removal of two older barns on the property.
