A.C.E. Building Service chosen for Satori's new collision repair center

A groundbreaking ceremony was held at Satori's Auto Service in Manitowoc for a new auto body and collision repair center. Located at 1620 N. 30th Street, Satori's collision center will be constructed next to the auto repair center, on Manitowoc's north side.

The new facility will feature a 5,920 square foot Butler building with MR-24 standing seam roof, spray booth, frame rack, and other auto body equipment. A.C.E. Building Service was chosen as general contractor for the building, which is scheduled for completion in late September.

Satori's Auto Service, founded in 1997, is a mechanical repair shop that services and repairs import and domestic cars and light trucks. This addition will enhance their offerings with comprehensive auto body, paint, and collision repair services.
